Surprise Proposals by Claire

Mistake #1 — Choosing a Location That Looks Better in Your Head Than in Real Life

Why it ruins proposals:

- Too crowded
- Bad lighting
- No privacy
- Wind or noise ruining the moment
- Poor angles for photos

Claire's fix:

- Choose a location based on her personality
- Consider lighting, privacy, and timing
- Always have a backup plan for weather

Mistake #2 — Not Having a Weather-Proof Plan

Why it ruins proposals:

- Rain
- Wind
- Heat
- Sudden crowds

Claire's fix:

- Always have Plan B (and sometimes Plan C)
- Know which locations still work in bad weather
- Use sheltered or indoor alternatives

Mistake #3 — Trying to DIY the Setup (The Fastest Way to Ruin the Moment)

Why it ruins proposals:

- Stress
- Rushing
- Forgetting items
- Setup looks cheap or unfinished
- Logistics fall apart

Claire's fix:

- Use a professional
- Delegate the setup
- Focus on the moment — not the logistics

Mistake #4 — Not Thinking About the Photos

Why it ruins proposals:

- Missed reactions
- Blurry photos
- No real memory of the moment

Claire's fix:

- Hire a proposal photographer
- Choose someone who knows the location
- Plan angles and positioning in advance

Surprise Proposals by Claire

Mistake #5 — Overcomplicating the Plan (Too Many Moving Parts)

Why it ruins proposals:

- Too many moving parts
- Too much pressure
- One thing goes wrong — everything unravels

Claire's fix:

- Keep it simple
- Focus on emotion, not theatrics
- Use a proven proposal structure

Mistake #6 — Forgetting the Personal Touches

Why it ruins proposals:

- Feels generic
- Doesn't reflect your relationship
- Lacks emotional impact

Claire's fix:
